GUIDELINES:

- 1. Artwork must be inspired by the Jasper County Courthouse.
- 2. Artists who are eligible to enter must be students in grades Kindergarten through High School Seniors or Homeschooled living in Jasper County.
- 3. The artwork must be original and created by the submitting student artist.
- 4. The artwork may be created in any 2-D or 3-D media.
- 5. It can be 2-D, but no larger than 24 inches by 36 inches. For 3-D, the art work can be no larger than 24 inches by 24 inches by 36 inches.
- 6. Label the artwork on the lower right corner or attached to the bottom of the artwork with name, title, grade, and contact information.
- 7. 2-D images must be framed and ready to hang.
- 8. Only one artwork entry per person is allowed.
- 9. The artwork and entry form are due by Friday, October 29, 2021 in the Clerk's Office between 8 AM and 4 PM Monday through Friday or mailed to Kara Fishburn, 115 W. Washington Street, Suite 204, Rensselaer, Indiana 47978.
- 10. The winners will be displayed in the Jasper County Courthouse on Friday, November 12, 2021 for the open tour day.
- 11. The 125th Anniversary Jasper County Courthouse Committee will not assume responsibility for damage or theft in regard to the artwork.

- 13. Artwork must be collected on Monday, November 15, 2021 from 8 AM to 4 PM from the Jasper County Courthouse or by special arrangement. Any unclaimed work becomes the property of the Jasper County Courthouse.

Impartial judges not associated with the Jasper County Courthouse officers and staff will judge the Jasper County Courthouse 125th Anniversary Student Art Competition. Certificates will be awarded, and the art works will be displayed at the Jasper County Courthouse on Friday, November 12, 2021.

- 1. Grades K, 1, and 2: Best of Show
- 2. Grades K, 1, and 2: Honorable Mention
- 3. Grades 3, 4, and 5: Best of Show
- 4. Grades 3, 4, and 5: Honorable Mention
- 5. Grades 6, 7, and 8: Best of Show
- 6. Grades 6, 7, and 8: Honorable Mention
- 7. High School: Best of Show
- 8. High School: Honorable Mention

Winning submissions will be chosen on creativity, originality, craftsmanship, and aesthetic appeal. Winners will be selected for each of the four grade groups.

Top award winners will be displayed during the open hours, 8 AM to 4 PM on Friday, November 12, 2021.

As a condition of entry, the artist grants the Jasper County Courthouse 125th Anniversary Committee permission to reproduce photographs of the accepted art work for publicity, thank you notes, and newspapers with the artist and school/homeschool credited in print.
